b) Content

Research objectives:

Based on the theoretical analysis and practical development of supporting industries in Viet Nam, the assessment of its status and development policies, the dissertation proposes number of solutions and recommendations for the development of supporting industries in Viet Nam until 2020in the context of international economic integration.

Research mandate:

- From the theoretical basis and practical experiences of other countries, propose the concept of supporting industries in Viet Nam, thereby indicating the focus and bases for its formation and development.
- Evaluate the development status of supporting industries in Viet Nam until 2010, the bases for the its development including orientation, policies and laws; development strategy; development potentials; the growth of multinational corporations. On that basis, develop theperception of a development strategy for supporting industries in Viet Nam.
- Propose some key solutions and recommendations for the development of supporting industries in Viet Nam in the context of international economic integration.

Research methods:

The dissertation used a number of keyresearch methods, including economic modeling method, economic statistics method, comparison method, analysis and synthesis method, etc to clarify research objectives and mandate.

Main results and conclusions:

- (i) The dissertation has clarified the concept of supporting industries in Viet Nam, thereby indicating the focus and bases for its formation and development.
- (ii) The development of supporting industries in Viet Nam over the past few years is immature and weak in terms of the number of participating enterprises; its market share is small; and the linkages between suppliers and producers remain loose.
- (iii) The dissertation has evaluated the bases for the development of supporting industries in Viet Nam such as orientation, policies and laws; development strategy; development potentials; the development of multinational corporations; developed SWOT matrix to formulate the perception of a development strategy for supporting industries in Viet Nam.

The dissertation has studied the needs for supporting industries development in line with its development strategy until 2020 and the years beyond; combined research on the practical experiences of some other countries with that on the status of supporting industries development in Viet Nam over the past few years; and put forward a number of key solutions and recommendations, in the context of domestic and world developments, for the development of supporting industries in Viet Nam until 2020 and the years beyond.
